Men's Hostel Security Measures

Kelowna's Gospel Mission maintains the internal security of the Mission through architectural design elements which support security such as the functional entrance to the Hostel, interior locking systems, panic buttons for staff; security cameras, and a pull down screen for the Kitchen.

Intake Process:

- Locked baggage check downstairs – no luggage allowed in the sleeping quarters
- Locked storage for clothing and personal toiletries upstairs – no personal clothing or belongings in the sleeping quarters
- Provision of pyjamas and house slippers for clients using the emergency shelter

Kelowna's Gospel Mission General Code of Conduct:

1. No smoking inside the buildings
2. No one under the influence or in possession of alcohol or drugs allowed in the buildings
3. No dealing of drugs or illicit substances in or around Kelowna 's Gospel Mission
4. No knives or weapons allowed on Kelowna 's Gospel Mission property or in the buildings
5. No engaging in criminal activities in or around Kelowna 's Gospel Mission building, or in front of the adjacent buildings
6. No swearing, obscene or abusive language or attitude permitted in the buildings
7. No pornography or offensive materials permitted in the buildings
8. No fighting or displays of violence (including sexual harassment) permitted in the buildings
9. No damage or graffiti to Kelowna 's Gospel Mission or adjacent buildings
10. No food or drinks can be taken outside the buildings
11. No loitering in the vicinity of Kelowna 's Gospel Mission building
12. All backpacks, sleeping bags, luggage or personal belongings left unattended will be discarded
13. Personal items of registered guests left in storage room will be discarded after 24 hours

Failure to comply with the above Code of Conduct will result in immediate eviction and possible bar.
